## NATURAL STONE CARE GUIDE

- USE A MILD NON-ACIDIC SOAP WITH WATER AND DRY THE SURFACE IMMEDIATELY AFTER CLEANING.

GENERAL EVERYDAY CLEANING:

- USE A WHITE OR NON-DYED CLOTH TO PREVENT DYES LEACHING INTO YOUR STONE.
- AS NATURAL STONE IS POROUS ALL SPILLS SHOULD BE CLEANED UP IMMEDIATELY. FOR SPILLS SUCH AS RED WINE, BLOT THE SURFACE WITH A CLEAN, DRY CLOTH (WIPING WILL ONLY SPREAD THE SPILL OVER A LARGER AREA)
- USE CUTTING BOARDS, COASTERS, AND TRIVETS TO PROTECT YOUR COUNTERTOPS FROM SCRATCHES, STAINS AND BURNS.

MAINTENANCE:

- to Avoid residue build-up, we recommend using a stone cleaner a few times a week. use a properly formulated cleaning solution for optimum MAINTENANCE.
- ONCE A YEAR, CLEAN AND DRY YOUR STONE. THEN APPLY A NEW COAT OF SEALER.
- WINDOW CLEANER, ALCOHOL, AMMONIA, VINEGAR, ACID BASED OR ALKALINE CLEANERS
